**Re: TYPOGRAPHICAL ERROR IN TABLE 3.3 OF HYDROGEOLOGICAL STUDY – RESPONSE TO REQUEST FOR FURTHER INFORMATION – BIOMASS CHP PLANT AND ASSOCIATED ASH LANDFILL, NOBBER, CO. MEATH (ABP REG. REF. PL17.PA0013)**

Further to our telephone conversation this morning, please find enclosed a technical report prepared by our environmental consultant in respect of a typographical error in Table 3.3 of the Hydrogeological Study submitted in Response to RFI on Friday, 24<sup>th</sup> September 2010.

Table 3.3 from Section 3.3 of the Hydrogeological Study was not updated to show the revised calculations used for the assessment of the Zone of Contribution (ZOC). However, it is stressed that the correct figures were used in the assessment, and therefore the error was purely typographical.

The enclosed technical report displays both the original table and the amended table where the volumes for the current and predicted abstraction rates have been amended to reflect the actual calculated ZOC areas (m<sup>2</sup>).

An amended Figure 3.2 illustrating the ZOC is also enclosed. While this drawing was correct and based on the revised calculations (showing an accurate ZOC), the associated legend displayed the wrong area, which is now updated in line with the above.

We would be obliged if you could include the enclosed on the public file in order to alleviate any confusion in relation to the relevant Zone of Contribution. Should you have any queries in relation to the above or any aspect of the RFI Response, please do not hesitate to contact me.
